# DEEP IN THE HEART OF TEXAS

Coming off an uplifting 2021 event in Baltimore, we're now turning our attention to the Central Time Zone and the center (it's relative) of the Lone Star State. Our 2022 Annual Conference and Exposition will be in San Antonio, one of the most alluring cities you'll find anywhere. Delicious food, great shopping, fascinating culture, and unforgettable history are all found downtown, connected by the winding, world-famous River Walk.

Our conference hotel, the newly renovated San Antonio Marriott Rivercenter—with side-by-side ballrooms for general sessions and exhibits—is actually on the River Walk. There is a River Shuttle (boat) stop basically at the bottom of the hotel escalators. The main building of the hotel towers above the Shops at Rivercenter (a multi-level urban mall). Next door is the historic Menger Hotel, a Teddy Roosevelt haunt; and that's just across the alley from the Alamo, where Texas' fight for independence found its impetus and voice. A few blocks south is the King William Arts District. Walk north and you'll be in The Pearl, the start of the Broadway cultural corridor. This is definitely a city where you'll want to come early or linger longer.





## BUILDING BRIDGES... AND CROSSING THEM

Architect Robert Hugman's River Walk concept, incorporating winding pathways and bridges flanking the San Antonio River, was his beautiful solution to harnessing the flood waters that took 51 lives 100 years ago. The 21 bridges along the route utilize various architectural styles but serve one critical purpose: to unite the two sides of the river.

This architectural wonder serves as an inspiration for our conference theme. The troubled waters of fear, confusion, and dissension too often separate Christ followers who should be in fellowship; and they separate groups that should be working together to make a difference in society. But in Christ, we can bridge our differences. The Apostle Paul calls church leaders to do exactly this in 1 Corinthians 1:10. Come rediscover what unites us and learn how to build better bridges toward an exciting future.



We'll take a comfortable motor coach up to Austin and tour this 51-acre master-planned community that provides affordable, permanent housing in a supportive setting for men and women coming out of chronic homelessness. With its own farm and multiple businesses—plus a wellness and respite center in the works—this model is something that MUST be replicated across the continent. Our behind-the-scenes special tour will inspire you to take pictures and measurements. Come see how to propel your community into a lifestyle of service with formerly homeless neighbors.



Our trip home will take us through the historic town of Gruene (pronounced green, like the color). Talk about quintessential Texas. We'll have dinner at the Gristmill, perched on a hill above the lazy Guadalupe River. SPACE IS LIMITED ON THIS FIELD TRIP, SO REGISTER EARLY.

## HUD Symposium

We're sitting down at the table again with key staff from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and members of Continuums of Care (CoC) in the South-Central States. If you are from the Rawhide District, plus Kansas and Louisiana, we invite you to arrive early and be at the table because a CoC representative from your city will likely be there. (Watch for your personal invitation.) We'll talk about what on our streets is working and what's not, plus investigate some of the ways communities and service providers can better work together to reduce and ultimately prevent the seemingly overwhelming problems we are facing. We'll also look at the State of Homelessness in America report from the Council of Economic Advisors and see where there might be common ground.

Saturday, June 4, 1:30 p.m. – Until Whenever \$ ⌚



## Conference Registration Details

The rates shown apply to individual and associate members and their spouses, plus any other board and staff members of member missions. All registration fees are always transferable to a previously unregistered guest from a member mission. Any registration changes or additions after May 18 must be made on-site at the San Antonio Marriott Rivercenter. Registrations canceled before April 30 will be assessed a \$75 cancellation fee per person. If canceled after April 30, they will be assessed a \$150 cancellation fee per person. Only in cases of family emergencies might the cancellation fee be waived. All refund requests must be in writing and received by Citygate Network no later than Monday, June 13, 2022.
